RE: ELIGIBILITY TO SIT FOR UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS

This is to inform you that all classes commenced on 2nd January, 2024 for the ongoing semester and you are therefore required to take note of the following:

- 1. That the fees payment Policy available on the TU-K website, www.tukenya.ac.ke, clearly stipulates that "ALL Fees shall be paid in full within the first 8 weeks of the Term/Semester".
- 2. That for any student to be **eligible to sit for the End-of-Term/Semester examinations**, they MUST:
 - i. Have signed the Nominal Roll;
 - ii. **Have attended not less than 75%** of the total contact hours of each of the prescribed Course Units; and
 - iii. Have paid at least 60% of the fees by 23rd February, 2024 and have **ZERO** fee balances by 22nd March, 2024.
- 3. That students who fail to pay at least 60% of the fees by 23rd February, 2024 and have ZERO fee balances by 22nd March, 2024 will be required to defer their studies for a minimum of one (1) academic year and a maximum of two (2) academic years.

Please comply to avoid any unnecessary disruptions of your studies.
