
SUBJECT: RESPONSIBLE USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA

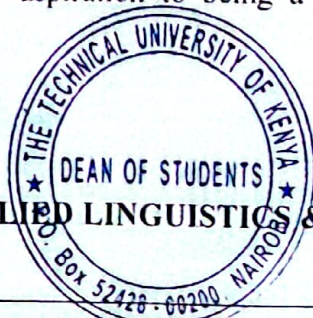

It is essential for the Student Fraternity to understand that any misuse, abuse, or inappropriate posts on social media by students or individuals associated with our esteemed University is a direct violation of our student code of conduct, university statutes, core values, and the laws of Kenya. We take the reputation and standing of our institution seriously and as a result, we will not tolerate nor condone such behaviour that can have a negative impact on both the education and personal lives of the students.


Consequently, any student misusing social media is liable to face the strict enforcement of the rules and regulations governing the conduct and discipline of students as outlined in Article 3 (a) (ii), (iii), and (iv) and Article 4 (a) (i), (ii), and (b) (vi), as well as the applicable laws of Kenya. It is crucial to remember that as individuals over the age of 18, you are bound by the laws of our country and may face legal action for any violations.

Thus, this notice serves as a reminder and a warning to all students about the importance of responsible social media usage.
