### FEBRUARY 2025, END-OF-SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

Friday, January 31, 2025

The university is aware that the staff unions—UASU and KUSU—have called for industrial action. However, we wish to **assure all students that the End-of-Semester examinations will proceed as scheduled from Monday, 3rd February 2025, to Saturday, 15th February 2025.**

The university has put in place **necessary measures to ensure that the examinations are conducted smoothly and without interference.**

All eligible students are reminded to be present for their examinations as per their respective timetables. Eligibility Requirements for Examinations:

*1. Self-Sponsored Students (All Years) & Government-Sponsored/KUCCPS Placed Students in Year Three and Above:*

You **MUST**:

- **Sign the Nominal Roll.**
- **Attend at least 75% of the total contact hours** for each prescribed course unit.
- **Clear all outstanding fee balances.**

*2. Government-Sponsored/KUCCPS Placed Students in Year One and Year Two (Under the New University Funding Model):*

- You **must report to the Admissions Office** to complete the registration process (**payment of fees is NOT mandatory** for registration).
- **Signing of the Nominal Roll is compulsory** to be eligible to sit for the End-of-Semester Examinations.

Students are urged to **strictly adhere to these requirements** to avoid any inconveniences.
