FEBRUARY 2025, END-OF-SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

Friday, January 31, 2025

The university is aware that the staff unions—UASU and KUSU—have called for industrial action. However, we wish to assure all students that the End-of-Semester examinations will proceed as scheduled from Monday, 3rd February 2025, to Saturday, 15th February 2025.

The university has put in place necessary measures to ensure that the examinations are conducted smoothly and without interference.

All eligible students are reminded to be present for their examinations as per their respective timetables. Eligibility Requirements for Examinations:

1. Self-Sponsored Students (All Years) & Government-Sponsored/KUCCPS Placed Students in Year Three and Above:

You MUST:

- Sign the Nominal Roll.
- Attend at least 75% of the total contact hours for each prescribed course unit.
- Clear all outstanding fee balances.
- 2. Government-Sponsored/KUCCPS Placed Students in Year One and Year Two (Under the New University Funding Model):
 - You must report to the Admissions Office to complete the registration process (payment of fees is NOT mandatory for registration).
 - Signing of the Nominal Roll is compulsory to be eligible to sit for the End-of-Semester Examinations.

Students are urged to strictly adhere to these requirements to avoid any inconveniences.
